Fadnavis inaugurates automatic weather station in Vidarbha:

Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis inaugurated the State's first automatic weather station at Dongargaon in Vidarbha region. It would help farmers plan and manage the sowing process better.

Around **2,065** such weather stations will come across Maharashtra on **Public Private Partnership (PPP)** model this year, and 1,000 of these will be set up by June.

Shri Bandaru Dattatreya launches two Schemes on International Labour Day:

Minister of State (I/C) for Labour and Employment, Shri Bandaru Dattatreya launched two schemes "One IP - Two Dispensaries" and "Aadhaar based Online Claim Submission" on the occasion of International Labour Day.

Under One IP - Two Dispensaries scheme ESIC has given an option to an Insured Person (IP) to choose two dispensaries, one for self and another for family through an employer.

Under Aadhaar based Online Claim
Submission scheme all EPF Members who have
activated their UAN (Universal Account
Number) and seeded their KYC (Aadhaar) with
EPFO will be able to apply for PF final
settlement, Pension withdrawal benefit and

PF part withdrawal from their **UAN Interface** directly.

Western Railways First Humsafar Express between Ahmedabad and Chennai was flagged off by Railway Minister Suresh Prabhu at a function through video conferencing held at Udvada town in Valsad district in Gujarat.

Humsafar Express, comprising the airconditioned three-tier coaches, aims at providing a luxurious travelling experience to the common man.

Six months after note ban, Telangana tops in digital transactions:

Nearly six months after the government announced its **demonetisation drive**, the southern states of **Telangana**, **Kerala and**

Data from the **IT ministry** shows Telangana clocking 5900 e-transactions per 1000 people, with Kerala and Andhra Pradesh registering 4300 4100 and respectively.

MP first to switch to Jan-Dec fiscal year:

Madhya Pradesh has become the first state switch to the January-December financial year from the existing **April-March cycle,** with the state cabinet. The move breaks a 150-year tradition as India the April-March financial started adopting year **from 1867**.

So, now the Budget session of the next financial year will be held either in December 2017 or January 2018, state Public Relations Minister Narottam Mishra.

Indore, Bhopal top cleanest cities list; UP cities rank lowest:

Indore in Madhya Pradesh is India's cleanest city, while Bhopal, located in the same state, is a close second according to a "Swachh Survekshan 2017" list of 25 Indian cities announced by Union Minister Venkaiah Naidu.

The Swachh Survekshan survey scores the Swachh Bharat or Clean India Mission in 434 cities across the country. Mysuru, which topped the list last year, has gone down to fifth spot this year. Dirtiest Place is Gonda in Uttar Pradesh.

International PermaCulture Meet to be held in Hyderabad:

India's most expensive limestone block in Chhattisgarh was auctioned:

The country's most expensive third **limestone block** in **Chhattisgarh** finally went to Dalmia (Bharat) Cement.

The **Kesla-II limestone block** in **Raipur district** of Chhattisgarh with an estimated reserve of **215 million tonnes** was put for auction.

President Pranab Mukherjee approves banking ordinance on Non-performing Assets:

President **Pranab Mukherjee** approved an ordinance on **Non-performing Assets** (**NPA**) which will provide greater powers to **Reserve Bank of India** to **tackle mounting bad loans**. Earlier, the Cabinet had approved promulgation of the ordinance to amend the **Banking Regulation Act** for resolution of the **Non-Performing Asset** (NPA) crisis.

Odisha increased the pension amount of freedom fighters:

The Odisha government announced an increase in the monthly State Pension for freedom fighters. **Chief Minister Naveen**

Patnaik gave his approval for the hike, urging the Finance Department to issue necessary notification.

Jailed freedom fighters for participating in the freedom struggle will now be entitled to Rs.10,000 pension per month, increasing from the present Rs.6, 000.

The freedom fighters who were **not jailed** and took part in **'Goa Mukti Andolan'**, will also get enhanced pension. They will get **Rs 9,000** instead of **Rs 5,000**.

Committee formed to review Mizo peace accord:

Mizoram Governor Lt. General Nirbhay Sharma has constituted a committee to review the peace accord signed between the Centre and the erstwhile underground Mizo National Front (MNF) on June 30, 1986.

The committee officially named as the 'Peace Accord Review Committee' would be chaired by Chief Minister Lal Thanhawla.

The boat ambulance service will be available in the districts of **Koraput**, **Malkangiri**, **Kendrapara** and **Kalahandi**. This is part of an MoU signed between the **State Government** and the **Ziquitza Health Care**.

Jharkhand government partners with Oracle to boost IT infrastructure:

In a bid to ramp up its IT infrastructure, the **Jharkhand government** signed a Memorandum of Understanding with **US-based technology major Oracle** to **enhance delivery of services** to citizens as well as make the State more attractive for start-ups. It will create increase employment and alleviate poverty.

DIPP, WIPO to set up Technology and Innovation Support Centres for IP generation:

Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) and the World Intellectual Property Organisation (WIPO) have joined hands to establish Technology and Innovation Support Centres (TISC) in the country which is expected to boost generation and commercialisation of intellectual properties.

Get train tickets at your doorstep by pay on delivery:

IRCTC is now offering **home delivery of rail tickets** and will allow passengers to make
payment through any payment mode, including
cash.

Broad-basing the customer service, the Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation has now introduced **pay-on-delivery** service, allowing passengers to book train tickets online and pay at the time of delivery.

PM Modi launches Supreme Court's Integrated Case Management System:

Air India to operate direct flight between Colombo and Varanasi:

PM Narendra Modi announced that from August this year, **Air India** will operate **direct flights** between **Colombo** and **Varanasi**. He is participated in the **International Vesak Day** at Bandaranaike Memorial International Conference Hall in Colombo, **Sri Lankan**, the biggest festival of Buddhists.

West Bengal to set up plant tissue culture laboratory:

The West Bengal government has decided to set up a **state-of-the-art plant tissue culture laboratory** at the **Kolkata Biotech Park** to enhance production and quality of plants and vegetables.

PM Modi inaugurates super specialty hospital in Dickoya:

Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated a Rs. 150 crore super-speciality hospital in Srilanka built with India's assistance in Dickoya, home to a large Tamil community who are of Indian-origin. Sri Lankan President Maithripala Sirisena attended the function with Modi.

India test-fires 'Spyder' surface-to-air missile from Odisha test range:

India, test fired a surface-to-air missile 'Spyder' from a test range in Odisha as part of missile launch practice of a series of tests of the short-range quick reaction.

Spyder (Surface-to-air PYthon and DERby) is an acquired missile system from Israel which is a short-range, quick reaction surface-to-air missile to neutralise enemy targets up to a distance of 15 km and at heights between 20 and 9,000 metres.

Aadhaar not mandatory for PAN in Assam, J&K:

The government has exempted residents of Assam, Jammu & Kashmir, Meghalaya, non-resident Indians, foreigners or any citizen above 80 years of age from mandatory quoting of Aadhaar while filing income tax returns or to obtain a permanent account number, under Section 139AA of the Incometax Act, 1961.

Telangana First State to Have Logo for Vehicles Driven by person with Hearing Impairment:

The **logo** was designed by city-based graphic designer **Manikanta Annapragada** who was the

first person to obtain a driving licence under the **'hearing impaired' category** in the country.

The logo consists of a hearing impaired mark along with text saying, "Driver is deaf — Please watch out".

Election Commission of India Launches National Contact Centre to Educate Voters:

The **Election Commission of India** has launched the National Contact Centre and also gives a toll-free number **1800111950**.

With this, any citizen from anywhere across the country, can make a call to this number to get any information or to complaints either in English or Hindi. It is being operated by special software called **National Grievance Redress System**.

PM to unveil road map for "Narmada Seva Mission":

Prime Minister Narendra Modi will unveil a road map for the conservation of the Narmada River in Madhya Pradesh. The event will be organised at Amarkantak in Anooppur district where the river originates.

It will mark the conclusion of 'Namami Devi Narmade Seva Yatra'. The Narmada river conservation awareness campaign was launched in December last year.

Chennai. The park, an ultra-modern exclusive
facility for ornamental fish equipped with multispecies hatchery and live feed culture units, will
become operational in the next three months,
fulfilling a major requirement of the industry for
mass production of high value aquarium fish.

West Bengal government to introduce new fishing method 'cage culture':

West Bengal government is all set to introduce a new method of deep-sea pisciculture commonly known as **cage culture**. As the name suggests, the practice consists of culturing fish inside big floating cages in the middle of the sea.

Government will provide Rs 1 lakh crore DBT scheme in 2017-18:

The central government is targeting to disburse **Rs 1 lakh crore** through **Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT)** in the current financial year even as total pay-outs under the scheme since its launch is set to touch **Rs 2 lakh crore** May **month-end**.

BSF operation 'Garam Hawa':

The **BSF** has started operation 'Garam Hawa' in the western sector in Rajasthan, under which vigil along the international border with Pakistan has been stepped up. The operation will continue till May 23.

The Operation **main aim** is to reinforce and strengthen the BSF's vigil along the border during the summer.

Raneh waterfall awarded Best Holiday Award:

Indian Army gets its first artillery guns "ULH":

The Army has got its **first artillery guns** from **BAE Systems**. Two 155mm/39 caliber **ultra light howitzers (ULH)** will be trial firing

at the **Pokhran** field firing range in **Rajasthan**. It was brought from **United States**.

ISRO to launch 3 Communication Satellites:

Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) will launch three communication satellites GSAT-19, GSAT-11 and GSAT-20 in the next 18 months to boost internet speed across the nation.

First anti-tobacco film festival in Goa:

The first Goa Anti-Tobacco Film Festival will be held on May 31, and will screen over 30 films, which is organised by "The Entertainment Society of Goa (ESG)", the State government's entertainment wing.

The festival will select films to **spread** awareness on the ill effects of tobacco use and to decrease the occurrence of oral cancer in the State.

NITI Aayog held the first "Samavesh" meeting:

An aim to bring together **32 premier** educational and policy research institutions to catalyse the country's development process, government think- tank NITI Aayog held the first Samavesh meeting at New Delhi.

The Meeting was held under the cochairmanship of NITI Aayog CEO **Amitabh Kant** and Principal Adviser NITI Aayog **Ratan P Watal**.

Visakhapatnam and Beas Stations are the cleanest rail station:

Vishakhapatnam and Beas railway stations are the cleanest railway stations out of the 407 station in the country. The Darbhanga railway station in Bihar was the dirtiest among the busiest stations.

Under the A1 category – Vishakhapatnam (Andhra Pradesh) topped the list followed by Secunderabad (Telangana) and Jammu Tawi (Jammu and Kashmir) while in A category, Beas (Punjab) bagged the first position followed by Khammam (Telangana) and Ahmednagar (Maharashtra).

Lord Ram museum in Ayodhya:

Uttar Pradesh chief minister **Yogi Adityanath** gave in principle approval for grant of land for the purpose of a **grand Ram museum in Ayodhya**. Government has allotted **Rs.225 crore** to build a **museum**.

Modi will become the first Indian Prime Minister to visit Israel:

The Prime Minister **Modi** made the announcement of his visit to Israel during an event in **Surat**. He will visit to Israel in **July**.

This visit will be coinciding with the **25th** anniversary of the diplomatic ties between the two countries.

CCEA nods for railway project:

Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) approved the laying of railway tracks in Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh and Andhra Pradesh with an estimated cost of Rs.5,695 crore.

The CCEA also approved four laning of the 118-km Porbandar-Dwarka section of National Highway 8E in Gujarat.

Trujet was first airline to get air operator certificate:

A Trujet airway was first airline to get air operator certificate under the scheduled commuter operator category.

The move will enable the airline to operate flights under the **Centre's UDAN scheme** for regional connectivity. Trujet is **one of five airlines** to have won bids to operate on 128 routes connecting 70 airports under the scheme.

Prime Minister Modi to open African Development Bank Event:

Prime Minister Narendra Modi will arrive to inaugurate the African Development Bank (AfDB) Group's annual convention in Gandhinagar, Gujarat on May 23. The theme of the event is "Transforming Agriculture for Wealth Creation in Africa."

The luxurious train, **Tejas Express** set to be running between **Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus** and **Karmali** in **North Goa** on May 22. All preparations have been done for the launch of the 20-coach train, which will have **secured gangways, automatic doors**, and 22 new features.

Punjab launches campaign on Hypertension:

The **Punjab Health Department** has launched a State-wide programme to sensitise people about **hypertension** and to educate them on **healthy lifestyle** practices. The programme was launched to mark **World Hypertension Day** on May 17. Punjab State, Health and Family Welfare Minister: **Brahm Mohinder**

Maharashtra to form "Good Morning" Squad: The Maharashtra government has decided to form "Good Morning" squads in a bid to curb open defecation across the state and also asked to check whether residents have access to toilets.

Government Finalises Defence policy for bigger role of Private Sector:

The **Defence Acquisition Council (DAC)** finalised the broad contours of a long-term strategic partnership with the **Indian private** sector in defence manufacturing.

The **DAC** is the **top decision-making body** on **defence procurement**, chaired by Defence Minister **Arun Jaitley**.

Madhya Pradesh to devise Happiness Index:

Madhya Pradesh Government signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with IIT-Kharagpur (the only institute to have a Happiness Centre) for developing state Happiness Index. World Happiness Index 2017 India 122nd spot.

The State government had, in July last year, set up the **Anand Mantralaya** or **the Ministry of Happiness**, with Chief Minister **Shivraj Singh Chouhan** as its first "happiness minister".

E-classes in Maharashtra by December 2018:
