- Maharashtra CM M Devendra Fadnavis announced that state will digitize all government schools by December 2018 and will be equipped with modern technology.
- Suresh Prabhu inaugurates 24×7 free Wi-Fi internet service at 28 Konkan railway stations which has tied up with Syscon Joister at Kudal and Chiplun railway stations.
- The Kozhikode Town Station becomes city's first women and child-friendly police station in Kerala.
- PM Narendra Modi announced that Gujarat's Kandla Port (renamed as Deendayal Port Trust) will be connected with Chabahar port in Iran, to boost India's international trade.
- Major Nitin Leetul Gogoi was awarded COAS (Chief of Army Staff) commendation for sustained efforts in counter-insurgency operations.

- Former Greek Prime Minister Constantine Mitsotakis, one of Greece's most prominent veteran politicians died at the age of 98.
