#### **NATIONAL**

- 1. The nation is celebrating its **71st**Independence Day today and the main function was held at the Red Fort in the national capital where Prime Minister NarendraModi unfurled the National Flag synchronized with 21-Gun Salute. The Prime Minister called for an end to the "chaltahai" attitude of complacency, and its replacement with an attitude
- of "badalsaktahai" for positive change.
- 2. Maharashtra Chief
  Minister DevendraFadnavis launched "NamoYu vaRojgar Kendra" an initiative providing job opportunities to unemployed youth in Mumbai. There are various schemes like farmers weekly market, farmers mobile market and mother's tiffin, under this YuvaRojgar Kendra and they can get fresh and healthy food, as well as farm, produce procured directly from farmers.
- 3. **Infusion Nurses Society (INS)** a global authority in infusion therapy launched **India's first online course** on Infusion Therapy for nurses, under which it **aims** to train over 3,000 nurses in the vital medical procedure.
- 4. President Ram NathKovind has approved 112 Gallantry Awards to armed forces and paramilitary personnel on the occasion of the 71st Independence Day. The Awards includes 5 Kirti Chakras, 17 Shaurya Chakras, 85 Sena Medals (Gallantry), three NaoSena Medals (Gallantry) and two VayuSena Medals (Gallantry). Of all 112, 19 are posthumous.
- 5. **Prime Minister NarendraModi** launched a website to honour all the gallantry award\_\_\_\_\_

winners since Independence

- 6. India will host the next steering committee meeting of the proposed 1,814 kilometre-long Turkmenistan-Afghanistan-Pakistan-India (TAPI) gas pipeline, senior officials on both sides confirmed.
- 7. Maharashtra Chief Minister
  DevendraFadnavis inaugurated the
  next generation projection mapping
  system at the iconic Gateway of India in south
  Mumbai.
- 8. Indian Air Force embarked upon an all women camel expedition along with Border Security Force from Utarlai (Barmer, Rajasthan) to Attari (Amritsar, Punjab). The expedition will conclude on 30 Sep 17. The team was flagged off from Air Force Station Uttarlai. The expedition is planned with a team of 10 Women Air Warriors of IAF and 10 Women personnel from BSF.
- 9. The main building of the **Uttarakhand secretariat** will be named after
  former **President A P J Abdul Kalam**and this
  announcement was made by Chief Minister
  Trivendra Singh Rawat on Independence Day.
- 10. India's first railways disaster management village expected to come up near Bengaluru at a place called Hejjala by December 2018. It will be used to replicate train accidents so that real time rescue operations could be carried out to improve such efforts.
- 11. A limited edition silver coin on Lord Krishna will be released on Janmashtami on August 15 by the Republic of Chad in commemoration of the 5,244th birth anniversary of the Hindu God.
- 12. A special programme would soon be launched to prevent the spread of malaria in remote areas of Odisha's Ganjam district. The

- 13. The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, CCEA has approved the proposal of Department of Investment and public Asset Management, DIPAM for the strategic disinvestment.
- 14. The Union Cabinet has approved raising extra budgetary resources up to 9,020 crore rupees for Long Term Irrigation Fund in 2017-18. Finance Minister ArunJaitley said that the amount will be raised by NABARD through Bonds.
- 15. The **Union Law Ministry** forwarded to the **President** the Tamil Nadu government's proposed ordinance on **one-year exemption from NEET.** The ordinance will be applicable for only government medical colleges in the State.
- 16. The Union Cabinet chaired by the **Prime**Minister ShriNarendraModi has given its approval to the proposal to complete the balance works of the North Koel Reservoir

  Project in Jharkhand and Bihar at an estimated expenditure of Rs.1622.27 crore to be incurred during three financial years from the start of the project.
- 17. In order to facilitate the availability of FASTags for Electronic Toll Collection, NHAI has taken two revolutionary steps in consultation with RBI and NPCI. These include online sale of FASTags and offline sale through Common Services Centre (CSC) near toll plazas.
- 18. The Minister of State for Development of North Eastern Region (I/C), Prime Minister's Office, Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr. Jitendra Singh said that a North Eastern Cultural and Information Centre will be set up in Delhi soon. The project is expected to be completed within 1-2 years and at a cost of approximately Rs. 50-55 crores.

- 19. Congress vice-president Rahul Gandhi launched the Indira Canteen scheme a Karnataka state government initiative named after former prime minister Indira Gandhi aimed at providing food at low cost to the urban poor.
- 20. Energy Efficiency Services Limited (EESL), under the Ministry of Power, today signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) under the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas (MoPNG) for distribution of energy efficient appliances under the flagship UnnatJeevan by Affordable LEDs and appliances for All (UJALA) scheme.
- 21. The Union Cabinet chaired by the **Prime Minister ShriNarendraModi** has accorded its approval for creation of a **nonlapsable pool** in the Public Account for secondary and higher, education known as "**Madhyamik and UchchtarShikshaKosh"** (**MUSK**) into which all proceeds of "Secondary and Higher Education Cess" will be credited.
- 22. Union Minister for Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Dr. Harsh Vardhan, launched the "Harit Diwali, Swasth Diwali" campaign.
- 23. The Prime Minister interacted with Young Entrepreneurs at the "Champions of Change" initiative organised by NITI Aayog at PravasiBharatiya Kendra.
- 24. Industries in the north eastern and Himalayan states will continue to get tax exemption till March 2027, albeit as refund, under the current GST regime which was rolled out on July 1
- 25. The **Union Cabinet** cleared a MoU signed between **India and Sweden** on **intellectual property right (IPR) cooperation**, aimed at benefiting entrepreneurs, investors and businesses. This meeting is chaired by Prime Minister NarendraModi. It will enable India to

- 26. An MoU was signed between Government eMarketplace (GeM) SPV and the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), in the presence of Smt NirmalaSitharaman, Commerce & Industry Minister at UdyogBhawan, New Delhi. Smt S RadhaChauhan, CEO GeM and ShChandrajit Banerjee, DG, CII singed the MoU on behalf of GeM SPV and CII respectively.
- 27. Centre has **doubled** the child care **allowance** for women employees with disabilities to **three thousand rupees per month**.
- 28. Union Minister for Textile and Information & Broadcasting, SmritiIrani will arrive in Ranchi to inaugurate Orient Craft Textile facility at Irba near Ranchi in Jharkhand. It is being organised under special make in Jharkhand drive, called "Momentum Iharkhand"
- 29. A two day Chief Electoral Officers'
  Conference of all States and Union Territories
  commenced in New Delhi. It was inaugurated
  by Shri. A.K. Joti, Chief Election
  Commissioner of India and Shri. O.P. Rawat,
  Election Commissioner of India.
- 30. **NavikaSagarParikrama** is a project wherein a team of six women officers of the Indian Navy would circumnavigate the globe on an **Indian-built sail boat INSV Tarini**.
- 31. The **last date for filing**returns and payment of taxes under the **GST**regime has been extended by five days. The
  returns can now be filed till the 25th of this
  august monthFor taxpayers who have to claim
  credit for past taxes paid by filing form **TRANS**1, the last date for returns will be **August 28**th.
- 32. **MIT World Peace University**, the first of its kind in India, was inaugurated by **Chief Minister of Maharashtra DevendraFadnavis**.

- 33. The **Centre** has approved a nearly **Rs**32,000 crore plan for the **Coast Guard** that will give more teeth to **the maritime security**agency in maintaining vigil on coastal waters
- 34. Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare JP Nadda will launch 15 medical outlets of AMRUT Deendayal in Assam, Uttar Pradesh and Punjab through Video Conference from Shimla. The purpose of AMRUT Deendayalprogramme is to provide different kind of medicines and equipment's on cheap rates to the patients. The discount up to 60 percent on MRP is provided to the patients.
- 35. The **Assam government** has proposed ambitious project to improve rural road connectivity. Managing Director of Assam State Transport Corporation A P Tiwari said that government is mulling to start **Chief Minister's LokParivahanYojna.**
- 36. **State-owned Indian Oil Corp (IOC)** will invest about **Rs 52,000 crore** in expanding **Paradip refinery** and setting up **petrochemical complex** after the **Odisha government** agreed to restore part of tax incentives.
- 37. The Union government is all set to double the metro rail network over the next 18 months, adding three new cities to the metro map.Lucknow Metro would be the first off the block as it has received safety clearance and would be inaugurated within this month
- 38. The Ministry of Defence has decided to delegate administrative and financial powers to the Border Roads Organisation (BRO) to avoid delays on account of references between the Chief Engineer, HQ DGBR and the Ministry. A chief engineer of the BRO can accord administrative approval up to Rs. 50 crore, ADGBR up to Rs. 75 crore and DGBR up to Rs. 100 crore.
- 39. The Prime Minister, **ShriNarendraModi**, reviewed the progress of two key schemes related to the **agriculture sector Soil Health Cards**; **and PradhanMantriFasalBimaYojana**.
- 40. The **Cell for IPR Promotion and Management (CIPAM)**, a professional body

41. Union Minister of State (IC) for Power, Coal, Renewable Energy and Mines, ShriPiyushGoyal, addressed a distinguished gathering of delegates attended 8th World Renewable Energy Technology Congress in New Delhi. The Minister also gave away Energy and Environment Foundation Global Excellence awards 2017 during the inaugural session of the conference.

#### INTERNATIONAL

- 1. **India** and **Turkmenistan** discussed joining the **Ashgabat Agreement** that envisages establishment of International Transport and Transit Corridor between Iran, Oman and Turkmenistan.
- 2. **Melbourne** has been declared the **most liveable city** in the world for the seventh year
  running by **the Economist's annual global liveability survey**, while **Sydney** remains in
  11th place. It is the **first time** in the survey's
  15-year history that a city has held the No 1 rank
  in its own right for seven consecutive years.
- 3. Italy will host a summit of Group of Seven Interior Ministers centered on security issues in the fall. Italian Interior Minister Marco Minniti said, the meeting is being organised at the request of Italy's G-7 partners- Canada, France, Germany, the United Kingdom, Japan and the United States.
- 4. **Nepal and China** signed **three pacts** to further boost their **ties in power and energy sectors**. The pacts were signed to undertake a feasibility study to **excavate natural gas** and **petroleum** in the Himalayan country, including in the southern Terai plains.

- 5. China announced USD 1 million assistance to flood-hit Nepal as the country's Vice Premier Wang Yang held talks with his Nepalese counterpart on ways to enhance bilateral ties.
- 6. **President Donald Trump** has **signed** into law an **updated veterans' education bill** that marks the largest expansion of college assistance for military veterans in a decade.
- 7. Despite growing tensions with China, official sources said the Indian Navy would join the **People's Liberation Army (PLA) Navy** in a maiden maritime search and rescue exercise to be chaired by **Bangladesh** at the **Indian Ocean Naval Symposium (IONS)** in November this year.
- 8. The **Nepal** government has announced to release **Rs.1 billion** to **flood and landslide victims**. The decision was taken at a meeting of the Prime Minister Disaster Relief Fund Committee held at Kathmandu.
- 9. **India and Russia** will hold a **mega military exercise** in **October** involving their armies, navies and the air forces for the first time to further ramp up military ties.
- 10. The exercise "Indra", which will be held in Russia from 19 to 29 October, will primarily focus on achieving coordination between forces of the two countries in a tri- services integrated theatre command scenario
- 11. India is deploying along its volatile border with Pakistan a smart Israel-developed fencing system having a 'quick response team' mechanism which strikes when the CCTV-powered control room detects an infiltration attempt. The BSF is implementing an ambitious project called the Comprehensive Integrated Border Management System (CIBMS) as part of the NarendraModi government's plan to completely seal the Indo-Pak and India-Bangladesh borders in the next few years.

Norway has jumped from 11th to first place on the list of world best providers of fast Internet connection.

- 13. India and Turkmenistan reviewed the entire bilateral relations and took stock of the progress achieved in key areas like energy, trade and security, the Ministry of External Affairs said. The Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Minister of Turkmenistan Rashid Meredov led a high-level delegation comprising senior officials of the Government of Turkmenistan to New Delhi from August 13-15
- 14. **SpaceX** successfully launched **Hewlett Packard Enterprise's (HPE) 'Spaceborne Computer'** towards the International Space Station using **Falcon 9 rocket**.
- 15. **Sir David Attenborough** finally earned his wings after scientists named a **100-million-year-old damselfly**after the veteran broadcaster and naturalist. Researchers led by Professor Edmund A. Jarzembowski have formally named the insect
- as **Mesostictadavidattenboroughi** as a belated 90th birthday present to the world's most famous naturalist.
- 16. Qatar has launched a new direct route between the country's Hamad Port and Pakistan's port of Karachi.
- 17. The US and Japan have agreed to advance their multilateral security and defence cooperation with countries like India, South Korea and Australia, amidst China's growing assertiveness in the Asia Pacific region.
- 18. Five Indian-origin persons have featured in Fortune's annual list of 40 young and influential people (40 under 40)in the field of business inspiring others with their

work. The Indian-origin 26-year-old **Divya Nag** who oversees Apple's ambitious ResearchKit and CareKitprogrammes has been ranked 27<sup>th</sup>. **Rishi Shah**, 31, and **ShradhaAgarwal**, 32, who helm more than 10-year-old health-tech firm Outcome Health have been ranked **38th** on the list. **Leila Janah (31)** CEO and founder of non-profit Samasource has been ranked **40th** on the list.

- 19. **Emma Stone** has been named **Hollywood's best-paid female actor** in Forbes' annual list of top earners. The 28-year-old made \$26m in the last 12 months
- 20. US President **Donald Trump** and Prime Minister **NarendraModi** agreed to enhance **peace** and **stability** in the Indo-Pacific region by establishing a new two-by-two ministerial dialogue. The new format would include **External Affairs Minister SushmaSwaraj** and **Defence Minister ArunJaitley** and their American counterparts **Secretary of State Rex Tillerson** and **Defence Secretary James Mattis.**
- 21. **China** launched its **first cyber court specialising** in handling internet-related cases in the **e-commerce hub of Hangzhou** amid a spike in the number of online disputes.
- 22. NASA has launched the latest in a series of satellites aimed at ensuring astronauts at the International Space Station can communicate with Earth.
- 23. The **\$408** million Boeing-made **Tracking** and **Data Relay Satellite (TDRS-M)** soared into space atop an Atlas V rocket that launched from Cape Canaveral, Florida.
- 24. The annual ten day "Ulchi Freedom Guardian" joint military exercise between the US and South Korea began.

#### **BANKING & BUSINESS**

1. Government has directed internet majors – Google, Facebook, Whatsapp, Instagram,

Microsoft and Yahoo – to immediately remove the links of dangerous online game "Blue Whale Challenge", which has led to suicide of children in India and other

countries. **Mumbai** and **West Midnapore** district have reported deaths linked to this game.

- **2. Retail inflation** rose to **2.36 per cent** in July this year, chiefly driven by hardening prices in sugar and confectionery items, pan, tobacco, and intoxicants. Retail inflation, as measured by the consumer price index, had stood at 1.46 per cent in June.
- **3. Wholesale inflation** rose to **1.88 per cent** in July this year, year-on-year, as the prices of some commodities increased. Inflation based on the wholesale price index had stood at 0.9 per cent in June this year, and 0.63 per cent in July last year.
- 4. The country's exports grew **3.9 percent** in July this year, on a yearly basis, to 22.5 billion dollars. Exports rose due to an increase in shipments of petroleum, chemicals and marine products. Official data showed that imports rose **15.4 per cent** in July, to 34 billion dollars, due to a rise in inward shipments of crude oil and gold.
- 5. ICICI Prudential Mutual Fund has launched a new website 'PlanYourGoal.com' to help users plan their investments according to their future financial goals.
- **6.** The **government** has imposed a **new penalty of \$ 264 million** (about Rs 1,700 crore) on **Reliance Industries Ltd** and its partners for producing less than the targeted natural gas from eastern offshore KG-D6 fields in 2015-16.
- 7. Reserve Bank has made Aadhaar linkage mandatory for farmers who wish to avail short-term crop loans in 2017-18. In a notification issued from Mumbai, RBI has advised banks to make Aadhaar linkage compulsory to ensure hassle-free benefits to farmers under the Interest Subvention Scheme.

- 8. The international exchange from **BSE**, **IndiaINX**, received an approval from the regulator, **Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI)**, to commence trading in Gold Options contracts the **first for India at GIFT IFSC**.
- 9. National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) has conferred the 'best performance award' for 2015-16 and 2016-17 to Karnataka VikasGrameen Bank (KVGB) for its work in the field of creditlinking joint liability groups (JLGs).
- 10. The **Kumbakonam-headquartered bank** introduced the option of an "**instant credit card**" for free for its Net banking customers.
  And, the product, which was soft-launched, seems to have caught the fancy of its customers instantly.
- 11. A Grant Agreement from the Global
  Environment Facility (GEF) of the World Bank
  of USD 24.64 million for "Ecosystem Service
  Improvement Project" was signed by
  Shri Sameer Kumar Khare, Joint
  Secretary (MI), Department of Economic Affairs
  (DEA), Ministry of Finance on behalf of the
  Government of India and
- Mr. **HishamAbdoKahin**, Acting Country Director for India on behalf of the World Bank. The project's duration is **5 years**
- 12. **KarurVysya Bank** unveiled **the Aadhaar Enrolment Centre** here following UIDAI's directive last month.
- **13.** HDFC Bank Ltd cut interest rates on most of its savings accounts
- to **3.5%** from **4%.** Customers with savings bank account balance of **5 million rupees** and above will continue to earn interest at **4 percent per annum**.
- 14. RBI will shortly issue new banknotes of Rs 50 denomination in the Mahatma Gandhi (New)

A **RBI press release** has informed that the base

- 15. The new notes will bear the picture of the iconic stone chariot at Hampi, Karnataka on the reverse, depicting the country's cultural heritage along with the Swachh Bharat logo, year of printing, numeral 50 in devnagiri and the language panel.
- 16. HDFC Bank cuts its savings bank interest rate, another private sector lender, this time **ICICI Bank** has cut its rate too. The bank announced that it has **slashed its interestrate by 50 basis points to 3.5 per cent** on deposits **below Rs 50 lakh**.
- 17. **BSNL** unveiled its mobile wallet in partnership with **MobiKwik** to enable one-tap bill payment for its over **100 million subscribers.** The subscribers will also be able to use the digital wallet at over 1.5 million merchants across India.
- 18. Telecom regulators of 23 countries from the Asia-Pacific will meet in Delhi this month to discuss challenges in framing rules for digital ecosystem and regional roaming, among others. Regulatory heads of Australia, Afghanistan, Iran, Malaysia, Bangladesh, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Vanuatu, Fiji and some others are slated to attend the international meet.
- 19. Union Bank of India entered into a corporate agency agreement with Bajaj Allianz General Insurance and Cholamandalam MS General Insurance for distribution of their insurance

products.

- 20. The first regional centre of the New Development Bank, set up by India and other BRICS nations, was officially opened by South African President Jacob Zuma and the banks Indian head K V Kamath. The idea was proposed by India at the 4th BRICS summit in 2012 at New delhi.
- 21. State-run power transmission utility
  Power Grid Corp said it will get a loan of \$500
  million from the Asian Development Bank
  (ADB) for its various projects.

- 22. The mergers of regional rural banks that are ordered by the government are now exempt from seeking CCI approval, according to a notification a move that will lead to faster closure of such transactions. The exemption has been granted for a period of five years.
- 23. The **government** has **extended till March** a cash back scheme that **offers incentives** of up to **Rs.1,000** to merchants for accepting payments through the Bharat Interface for Money **(BHIM)** application.
- 24. **Axis Bank** will waive **12equated monthly installments** (EMIs) on regular repayments of loans of up to **Rs. 30 lakh** under the new scheme **ShubhAarambh Home Loans**.
