NATIONAL

- Centre and Jammu and Kashmir Government have resolved to use education as a tool to bring normalcy to the state. The Central and State Governments signed a Memorandum of Understanding at the 65th Central Advisory Board of Education (CABE) meeting in New Delhi.
- ❖ The union sports ministry's ambitious programme, 'Khelo India', an initiative to scout for talent at the grassroots and provide it substantial long-term scholarshipwill be launched on January 31.
- ❖ The Punjab government signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Indian Oil Corporation to set up bio-gas and bio-CNG plants in the state.
- ❖ West Bengal has the highest number of MSMEs in the country with 52,69,814 units. Uttar Pradesh ranked second after West Bengal, followed by Maharashtra. Gujarat stood eighth with 4.89 percent of the MSME share.
- The Centre has sanctioned projects over 10,000 crore rupees in the North East for better network connectivity.
- Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas has been launched 'Saksham 2018'. It is a vigorous and high intensity one-month mega campaign of Petroleum Conservation Research Association (PCRA).
- Odisha govt. has launched Mukhyamantri Kalakar Sahayata Yojana (MMKSY) for artists. Under this yojana artists will receive a financial assistance of Rs. 1200 per month.
- Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu inaugurated the third edition of the geopolitical conference, 'Raisina Dialogue', in New Delhi.
- India test fired Intercontinental 5000-km range surface to surface nuclear capable ballistic missile Agni-V.
- ❖ The Punjab government signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Indian Oil Corporation to set up bio-gas and bio-CNG plants in the state.
- The second day of the 65th Meeting of the Central Advisory Board of Education (CABE) was held in New Delhi.
- ❖ Bangladesh, India and Nepal have given nod to operating procedures for movement of passenger vehicles in the sub-region under Bangladesh-Bhutan-India-Nepal (BBIN) motor vehicles agreement.
- ❖ The 15th edition of BioAsia, the annual flagship event of the Government of Telangana, will start in Hyderabad.

- Home Minister Rajnath Singh has launched Bharat Ke Veer anthem and also a short film on India's bravehearts.
- ❖ The fourth edition of the India International Science Festival will be held in Lucknow.
- The Maharashtra government has launched `Balasaheb Thackeray Shaheed Sanmaan' scheme.
- Uttarakhand planned to use ultrasound that will to detect pregnancy before administering reproduction control method on them.
- * Ramayana Festival, marking 25 years of the Indo-ASEAN ties began in New Delhi.
- The Post Office Passport Seva Kendra (POPSK) at Karaikal in the Union Territory (UT) of Puducherry was inaugurated by Smt. Sushma Swaraj, Hon'ble Minister for External Affairsat a function presided over by Shri V. Narayanaswamy, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Puducherry.

- India has contributed \$50,000 to UN Secretary General Antonio Guterres's Office of Envoy on Youth to help with its mission of involving young people in the world body's goals.PaulomiTripathi, a First Secretary in India's UN Mission, handed over the contribution to the Youth Envoy, JayathmaWickramanayake.
- India and Sri Lanka signed four agreements for collaboration in ICT sector, setting up of e-office system and connecting of National Knowledge network (NKN) for collaboration among universities and academics.
- The bridge in **Akoka village** in the northern part of the land-locked country in East-Central Africa had been inoperable since last June when heavy rains washed away a 300-metre-long road segment.

- ❖ Reliance Industries Ltd. chairman and managing director Mukesh Ambani announced a investment of ₹5,000 crore, in addition to the group's investments about ₹15,000 crore made in the State.

- The Trump administration plans to open the US embassy in Jerusalem by the end of 2019.

- The Country's exports grew by 12.36 per cent in December, 2017 to 27.03 billion US dollars on account of strong performance by sectors like engineering goods and petroleum products.
- ❖ Tata Consultancy Services has signed a \$690-million (Rs 4,400-crore), 10-year deal with M&G Prudential, the UK and European savings and investments business unit of Prudential.
- Invoice Mart has tied up with state-run lender Bank of Baroda to discount invoices for MSMEs.
- The Gurgaon-based Amplus Energy Solutions has signed an MoU with India's leading bank Yes Bank for a strategic tie-up to co-finance projects in the solar energy sector in India.
- Shares of Housing Development Finance Corp. Ltd (HDFC) crossed Rs 5 trillion market capitalisation.
- ❖ Banking finance company AU Small Finance Bank has signed an MoU with LIC to offer Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY).

- ❖ Digital payments platform Paytm has unveiled an application called 'Paytm for Business' to enable small and medium businesses to accept digital payments.
- ❖ India was ranked at the 62nd place among emerging economies on an Inclusive Development Index, much below China's 26th position and Pakistan's 47th.
- India is projected to grow at 7.4% of its gross domestic product (GDP) in 2018 as against China's 6.8%, the International Monetary Fund (IMF), making it the fastest growing economy among emerging economies following last year's slowdown due to demonetisation and the implementation of goods and services tax (GST).
- The revenue department said the last date for GSTR-3B return filing for December has been extended by two days to January 22.
